We need your input to help make sure all voices are heard in planning our community's future. This summer and fall, watch for events and other chances to learn and participate.



#### Our work so far

In 2015, we started looking at transportation investments along seven key corridors. Since then, we narrowed our focus to five corridors: Highway 99, River Road, 30th Avenue to Lane Community College, Coburg Road, and Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard. Public input from 2015 – 2016 has helped determine what options are currently being considered.



We're looking at current and future land uses, environmental concerns, and community needs and values to decide what to fund, design and build over the next 10 years. As we invest in the future of our community, your feedback is vital.
